OSECHI is a traditional Japanese New Years meal.

The tradition started in the HEIAN period (797 – 1185). New Years Day is one of the five seasonal festivals (GO-SEKKU) in the Imperial Court in Kyoto.

Originally, during first three days of the New Year it was a taboo to use a hearth to cook meals, except when cooking OZONI. OSECHI was made by the close of the previous year, as women did not cook on New Years Day.

OSECHI are easily recognizable by their special boxes call JUBAKO.
